**Question:** Will a work plan be required?

*Answer: A work plan is not required but if there are updates or changes to your NWD/ADRC implementation from last year please submit in an attachment.*

**Question:** Do we need new letters of support?

*Answer: Letters of support are not required. However, if the applicant has identified any new additional partners which have not been previously identified it is recommended that they submit with their applications.*

**Question:** Is “Sec 2405” mentioned in the Statutory Authority section of the RFP (page 2 of 27) refers to the ACA?

*Answer: Sec 2405 does refer to ACA and authority to fund ADRCs. However, for this specific funding opportunity, no ACA funds are being used. All the funds to support this Funding Opportunity are ACL Discretionary dollars.*

**Question:** Are we supposed to include all the elements listed on pages 14/15 of the announcement? It asks for a problem statement and an intervention. For some of the other elements (evaluation, dissemination,) it gives the option to include only if there has been a significant change.

*Answer: Yes. Problem Statement, Goal(s) and Objective and Proposed Intervention are all required elements.*

**Question:** The grant instructions state that the summary abstract is to be single-spaced, with a one-page limitation and font size of no less than 11 point. However, the Summary/Abstract instructions that accompany the funding opportunity announcement for this grant on the ACL website provide that the summary/abstract must be 265 words or less, double-spaced and with a font size of no less than 11 point. Is it single spaced or double?

*Answer: You may submit single spaced summary abstracts.*
