- Store supplies and ensure return of kitchen equipment to proper locations
- Receive and properly date and store food and supply deliveries
- Perform other tasks that may be required

Requirements

- Basic understanding of recipes, math, and safe food handling
- Experience in sanitation procedures
- Ability to speak English
- Familiarity with safe food handling, sanitation, and storage procedures
- Ability to report to work on time
- Ability to maintain a good attendance record on a regular basis
- Good personal hygiene

- Large quantity cooking experience
- Experience working with volunteers
- Ability to relate well with older adults
- Bilingual

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, bend, use manual dexterity and multi-task. The employee will often be required to do heavy lifting of up to 25 pounds. The employee will use hands and arms in handling, installing, positioning, and moving materials and manipulating things. The employee is occasionally required to reach with hands and arms and do quick, repetitive motions with fingers, hands and wrists. Near vision or appropriate glasses/contacts are required to see details at close range.
