



Paralysis Resource Center State Pilot Grants: Subawardee Survey


Self-Evaluation and Application Process Metrics

In April and May 2020, the 29 state PRC pilot subawardees were surveyed to capture self-evaluation, application process, and outcomes information.




Application Process (n=26) - How satisfied were you with:






Community Impact

The majority of the state subawardee projects focused on expanding physical fitness and outdoor recreational opportunities for people with paralysis.
