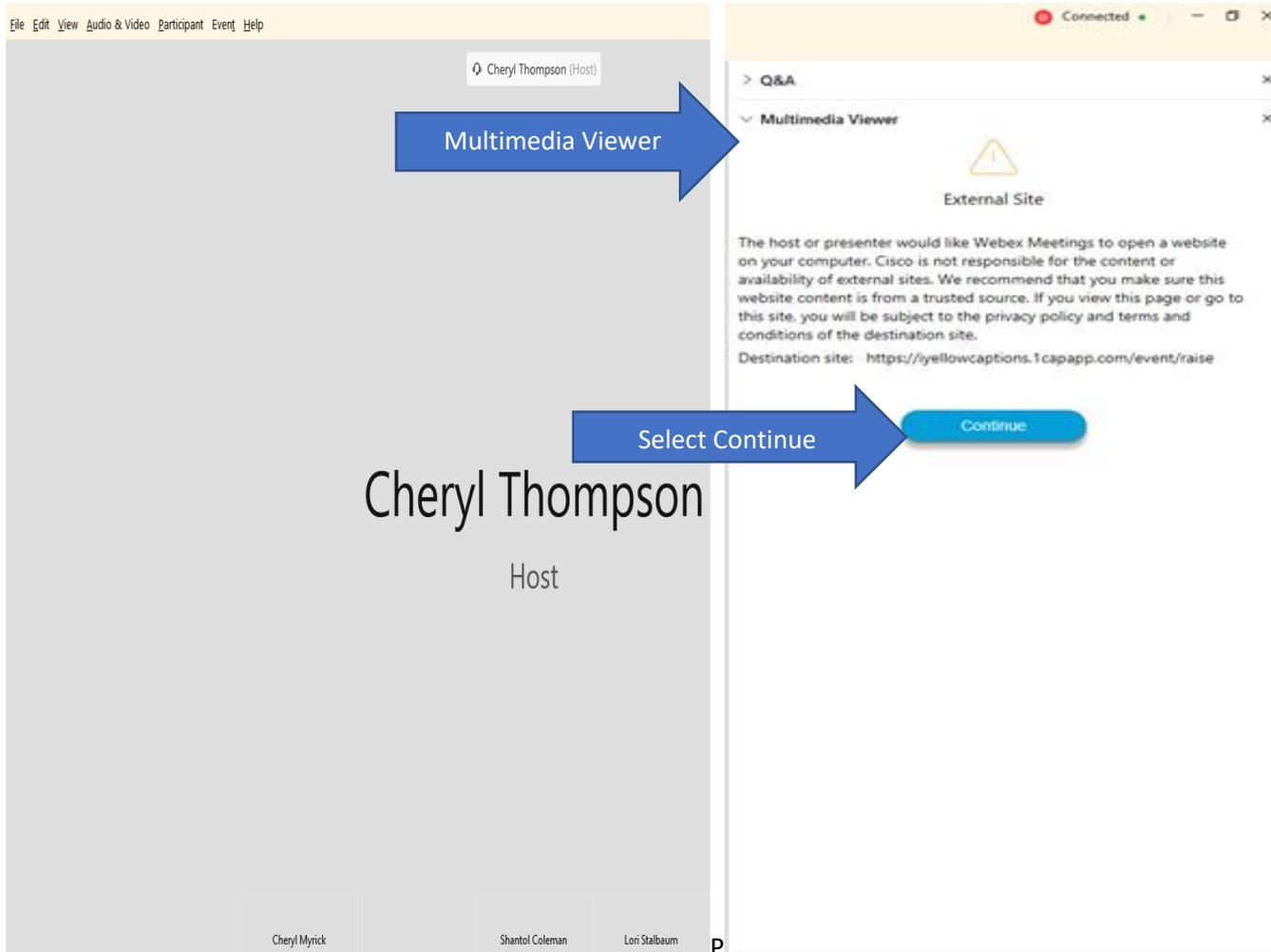


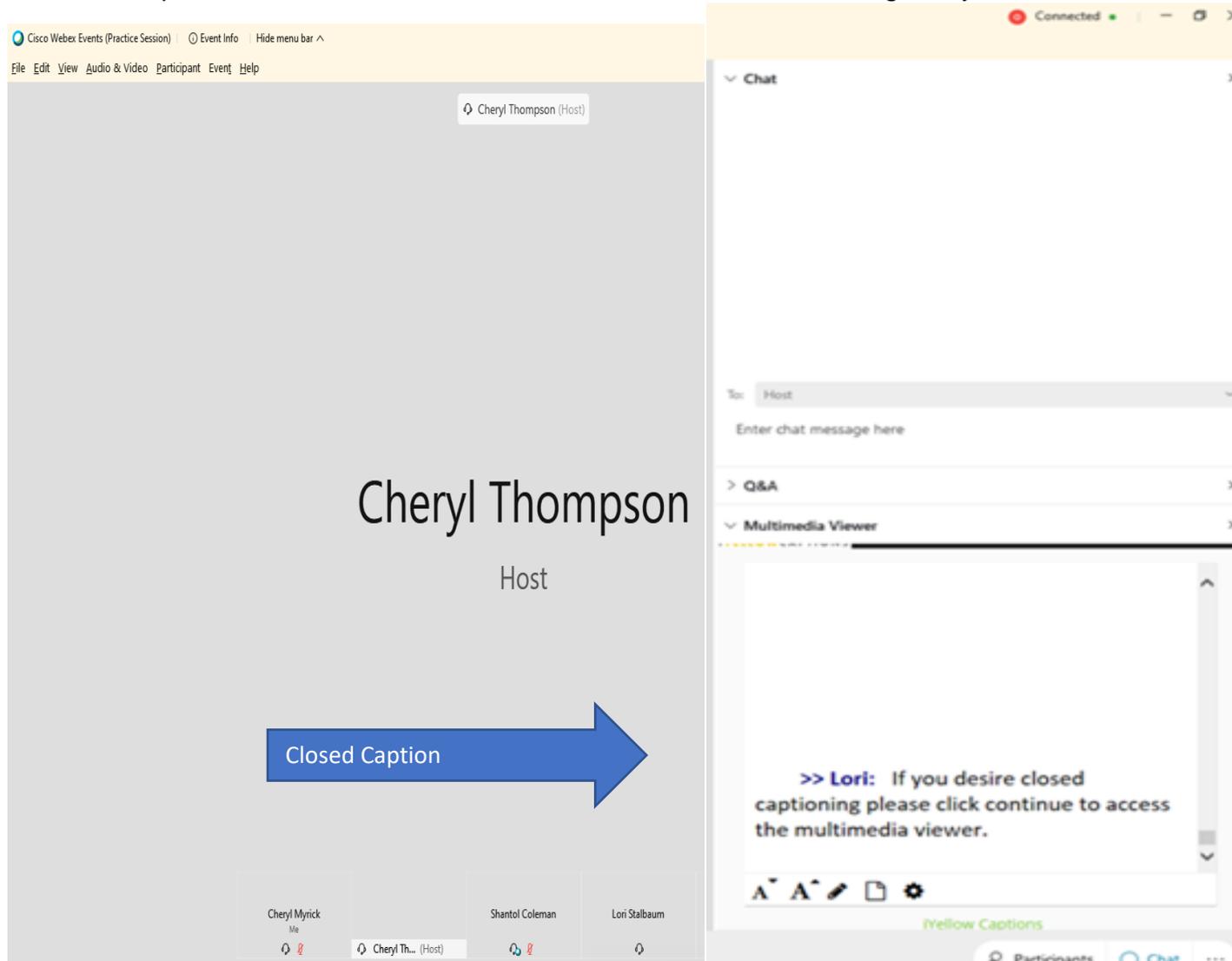
Instructions for Accessing Closed Caption

1. Upon logging into the Webex platform open the multimedia viewer to the right of your screen and click continue.
